SPEEDING BETWEEN TWYFORD AND COLDEN COMMON

Sue supports residents who are seeking lower speed limits along this stretch of the B3335 - there have been multiple accidents including a recent road closure here. The bends reduce sight lines and the volume of traffic makes it even more risky for users of any junctions. Several National Park footpaths cause pedestrians to cross the road and school children and students must cross the road or walk along unpaved sections to reach bus stops. The short distance between Twyford's 30mph and commencement of the lower limit again at Colden Common make it a section where drivers seek to overtake slow and large vehicles and to break the existing 50mph. Sue also wants wider footpaths, maybe even dedicated cycle paths.
